## Request for Partners - Hispanic/Latinx Program

Colorado Humanities requests proposals from pairs of community partner organizations consisting of a Hispanic/Latinx-serving organization and a non-explicitly Hispanic/Latinx-serving organization to develop a community program with the goal of furthering understanding of multiple cultural traditions, values, current experiences, and ideas. We are interested in working with Hispanic/Latinx serving organizations that are dedicated to advancing communal equity and justice through their work on projects that share Latinx history, culture, traditions, and stories, and non-explicit Hispanic/Latinx-serving organizations that seek to diversify their audiences for public programs.

We center community voices by directly supporting creative and collaborative projects designed for and by communities to celebrate their heritage. We invite explicitly Hispanic/Latinx applicants to submit program proposals by July 1, 2023 at <a href="https://coloradohumanities.org/programs/latino-heritage-live/">https://coloradohumanities.org/programs/latino-heritage-live/</a>. This opportunity is funded by the National Endowment for the Humanities.

# **Community Partner Requirements**

Each community partner must be willing to participate in design, planning, local outreach, implementation, evaluation, and reporting for a program. in an identified geographic community. Program design will be developed by partners in collaboration with Colorado Humanities.

## Plan

In 1,000 words describe the local partnership you would cultivate, including partners' roles, shared values, and goals informing your ideas for a program. Program planning will take place between July 1 and September 30, 2023. Program implementation will take place between October 1, 2023 and May 31, 2024. Each partner will identify a contact person who will be responsible for their organization's participation. Partners will identify which organization will manage funds and financial documentation.

# **Budget**

Please provide a draft budget for up to \$5,000 of project costs. Allowable costs include: event venues, catering, travel, honoraria, outreach, marketing, and other expenses related to planning, marketing, production, evaluation, and reporting for an in-person program or event.

May 15 to June 15 Applications accepted for submission

July 15 Notification of selected community partner/partners

July-September Collaborative planning

October 2023 – April 2024 Program marketing and implementation

May 2024 Program evaluation due to CH

June 30, 2024 Final report due to Colorado Humanities
